

# POKER RIDE RULES

## Register before the ride...

- ♣ All junior riders (16 & under) must wear an ASTM approved helmet.
- ♣ All junior riders must have an adult sponsor rider with them while riding the trails.
- ♣ Ride the trail at your own speed and enjoy your ride. ***This is not a race.***
- ♦ Please look after the well being of your horse, know your horse's fitness level and ride accordingly; there is no veterinarian available or on site
- ♥ Please use proper trail etiquette (ie: please don't gallop past groups of riders going slow, tie ribbon on horse's tail who are kickers etc.)
- ♣ Please be respectful... **NO CHASING Wildlife.**
- ♦ The route is flagged and you will also be given a map. All riders must stay on the marked trails.
- ♣ Follow the PINK ribbons on your right hand side. The loop is 12.5 miles. There is horse water on trail.
- ♦ Follow Blue ribbons on your right hand side for an additional 2 mile (Blue) Loop. There is water on trail ( Nine Mile Creek )
- ♥ Please **NO DOGS** on trail, all dogs must be on leash at all times
- ♣ **PLEASE NO SMOKING ON THE TRAIL** ... the fire hazard is high ... please be respectful of the property and the woods. *Thank you*
- ♥ There are 3 stations for card pick up on the trail and 2 at camp, pick up first card in camp, 3 on route and last card at camp. Name will be written on each card
- ♦ Upon return from your ride and into camp, settle your horse at your trailer or in a pen then come to the scrutinizer for poker hand evaluation.
- ♣ Following the ride, lunch will be served ... coffee, pop & water as well.
- ♦ Once all riders are in prizes will be awarded.

Please clean up manure and hay around your trailer or in horse pen before you leave.
